Dear parents/carers,

Firstly, a huge thank you to all those who were able to attend the Parent Forum on Wednesday. We were delighted with the strong attendance and the opportunity to answer questions about the Ofsted report and our development of the school moving forward. We have sent the slides separately by email. The last few slides contain our answers to the main questions asked by parents at the session.

As I shared at the Parent Forum, we have a lot of plans for the rest of this school year to help drive our school forward. We do not want to bombard you with these, but two letters you will soon receive from me are about a new method of reporting absences (an app called Studybugs, currently is used successfully at Park Mead Primary school) and a survey to decide what extra-curricular clubs you would like to see at the school. At present we offer two Clubs after school but our ambition is to increase this. Your support with this would be much appreciated.

The INSET Day today is another opportunity for staff to work together and again I would like to thank you for your flexibility as we moved this forward. It will be my role in the coming weeks to monitor this, now that I am employed at Ewhurst full-time, and report to Governors regularly.

I am looking forward to the first swimming lessons after half-term and you will have received an email about this earlier in the week. Finally, looking ahead to next week, we will be giving Friday 5 May a special Coronation focus, with some craft activities in class and a special coronation picnic lunch.
