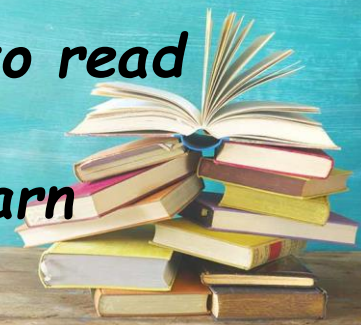
Mrs Johnston Year 2 Teacher
