Year 1 teacher

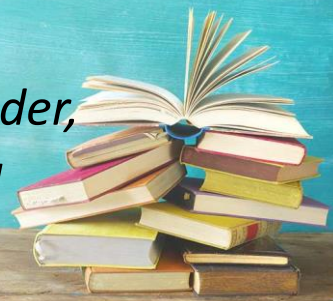
