Being safe at Ewhurst Infants:

If you have a concern about a child, however small, you can speak to any member of staff at school who will know the procedures to take to ensure that child is safe. You can also speak directly to one of the DSL team. In Celebration Assembly each week of this term I will be sharing with the children a 'safety scenario' to generate discussion on how to keep ourselves safe in that situation.
