Dear parents/carers,

Autumn has certainly set in, with fresh mornings and colder nights! We have noticed that there are a few runny noses and coughs around and want to thank you for doing all you can to keep your children healthy during this time. Good attendance is a high priority for us and I would be thrilled if as a school we could achieve above 96% attendance for the whole year! Autumn also means a chance to give thanks for this year's harvest. We are looking forward to celebrating a short Harvest service at the church on Monday 3 October at 9.15am. Parents and carers are warmly welcome. The children have been practicing some fun harvest songs in class and collective worship – their voices are sounding wonderful.

We are mindful that the school year has started at a pace but we have not paused to introduce ourselves or set out our plans for the year ahead. Our first Parents' Evening is on Wednesday 2 November, but we did not want to wait that long for us to introduce ourselves.
