Dear parents/carers,

Happy New Year to you all! It has been wonderful to have the children back in school this week. We've enjoyed hearing all their stories of holiday activities and trips. For some, Christmas has been affected by illness and we hope and pray for a healthy new year!

Our vision and mission for our school in 2023 remains the same. Our aim is, through an inspiring and aspirational curriculum, to ensure all pupils develop skills and knowledge, a strong moral code and a deepening understanding of the Christian faith to prepare them for life as global citizens. During our staff INSET day on Tuesday we reminded ourselves of this aim and how this is outworked through our six core values: love, perseverance, friendship, community, honesty and love. My staff team and I are ambitious about the school and moving it forward in 2023. We were very grateful for all those parents who filled in the December parent survey – we had many helpful suggestions on making our school even better and will let you have a summary of the results in the next few weeks.

This term we will sharpen our focus in two areas. The first is **reading**. We will conduct a Reading Audit of the school on 13 January, with support from the regional English Hubs and, as part of our 2022-23 Reading Action Plan, be investigating new ways of encouraging more reading throughout the school. This will include making more of our excellent library, for example by extending opening hours. We will keep you updated on progress. As a 'heads-up', remember we will be celebrating World Book Day on Thursday 2 March, so do be thinking now of a suitable costume! A second emphasis this term will be on **internet safety**. Some children may have received new devices over Christmas or might have spent extended time on electronics. Finally, a few quick reminders: the school gate opens at 8.45am and closes at 8.55am, so please do all you can to be on time! Collection is at 3pm as usual.
