Dear parents/carers,

It has been another wonderful week at school, with the children working hard. It is always a pleasure to walk into classes and see pupils enjoying their learning. We have been very fortunate to have Mr. Ward support us over the past two weeks but we are delighted that Mrs Johnston will return to Holly Class on Monday (23 January). She is itching to get back to the class and we can't wait to have all the staff back healthy and strong.

Next week is an exciting week! Cherry Class will be leading assembly on Wednesday 25 January at 2.40pm. Then on Friday, 27 January we have our monthly drop in to all classes from 3-3.30pm.
