Message from the church: Collection for Ukraine until 27th March 2023

Supporting Ukraine through British Humanitarian Aid (BHA) St Peter & St Paul Church Ewhurst continues to work closely with BHA. BHA still has local contacts in Chornobyl (previously known as Chernobyl) This helps BHA evaluate what is most urgently needed in that area as well as the wider picture. Phil from BHA has asked us to have the following urgently needed items in our March Collection:

Mobility aids for adults such as crutches, wheelchairs and collapsible walking frames (Not zimmer frames), Ladies bicycles, Adult and baby nappies, Sanitary pads/towels, Clothing for all ages, Shoes for all ages (please tie pairs together), all types of bedding, candles, matches, torches (Not gas or lighters), tools - (Not electric powered or gardening), sweets for children
