Dear parents/carers,

It's been an action-packed final week of the half-term! On Tuesday it was Safer Internet Day, when we thought about being safe online. It is easy to think that online safety is not an issue for under 7s, but it is vital that children learn from an early age what to look out for when they are using devices and build a strong understanding of good principles throughout their school life. We also want all parents to be vigilant about what their children are looking at and doing online, particularly if they are using devices without filters, such as an adult's phone. At Ewhurst we have 4 ways to be safe when going online. This week we focused on telling a grown up if something pops up that we are not expecting such as an advert, asking us to buy something or the next program. We encouraged children to tell an adult, but not to click on the unexpected link. We will continue to highlight the importance of esafety throughout the year.
